

Kickoff meeting of the project “Sustainable ICT use in Education: Developing Teacher Training Material using ICT” in Mongolia

- Funded by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Japan

The kickoff meeting of second phase of “Sustainable ICT use in Education: Developing Teacher Training Material using ICT” Project, was held in Mongolian State University of Education in Ulaanbaatar city on June 16. The Mongolian participants includes project coordinator, Ministry of Education officials, members of VCD development teams of 5 subjects, translators. Professor Yamaguchi of Global Science Information and Computing Center, and Morigendalai and Yano Shotaro, graduate students from Tokyo Institute of Technology have attended.

Professor Yamaguchi made opening remarks in the beginning of the conference, introduced the history of this project and explained the plan of project activities such as international conferences to be held in September. Prof. Sukhbaatar, the project coordinator, introduced the VCD products and materials which were produced during the first phase of this project, in Dec 2010 - March 2011. The VCD development teams of 5 subjects, namely, Mongolian language, Human and Environment, Communication, Music, and Sports reported the contents, features, and structures of the materials. The report also include the progress of the work, and schedule of this month.

During the meeting, the graduate students of Tokyo Institute of Technology made presentation to the VCD development teams of 5 subjects. The presentation introduced 3 applications as a development tool for interactive teaching materials for primary school teachers, and demonstrated the examples of teaching materials. The VCD development teams of 5 subjects conducted group discussions to collect and summarized impressions of these 3 applications.

At the end of the meeting, questions and answers on related activities, and future plans of project was held.
